

Upgrade Instructions - GS1net Browser Template v5.2-4

For **New** Installations, please refer to 'Installing the Browser Template' within the GS1net Browser Template User Guide.

A new Browser Template spreadsheet is installed as part of the Version 5.2-4 upgrade. To ensure that all existing Item and Price records are available to be re-imported into the new Version 5.2-4 Browser Template, one of two pre-installation options must be undertaken.

Option One:

1. From the GS1net 'Supplier Catalogue Item List' screen **download** and save your GS1net catalogue as a Delimited Data File (DDF).

Note 1: For detailed instructions, refer to 'Importing a GS1net Delimited Data File' within the GS1net Browser Template User Guide. Do not import the DDF until after the Version 5.2-4 upgrade.

Note 2: Users should select 'Reset' prior to selecting 'Search' from within the GS1net 'Supplier Catalogue Search' screen. The 'Reset' function ensures that all selection filters have been removed.

Note 3: Use option Two if you have updated or added new Item or Price records within the Browser Template but have yet to successfully upload the additions/changes.

Option Two:

1. **Open** the GS1net Browser Template (current version).
2. **Insert** the command '**ADD**' within column '1=Action' for all Item and Price records.

3. **Select** 'Create GS1net Delimited Data File' from the GS1net menu

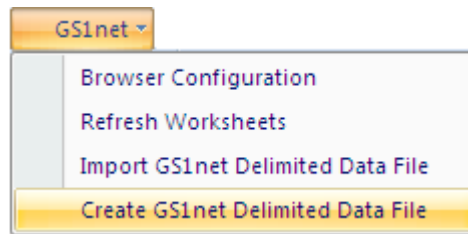


Figure 2 – Create GS1net Delimited Data File

Note: It is important that you are able to locate the Delimited Data File as it will be required to 'populate' the new GS1net Browser Template.

4. **Close** the GS1net Browser Template

Installing the GS1net Browser Template

1. **Download** the zip file from the GS1 Australia website, extract the setup file and **save** the file to a location on your computer (a location other than the GS1net directory is strongly recommended).

Note: For Excel 2000 & 2003 users, select the '.xls' version, for Excel 2007 & 2010 users, select the '.xlsm' version.

2. **Run** the Browser Template v5.2-4 setup program and follow the instructions.

Note 1: When selecting the installation directory, if the current GS1net directory is selected (pre v5.2-4 version) the existing '**configuration.ini**' file is maintained. This will ensure that your Browser Configuration settings are maintained.

Note 2: To maintain existing configuration settings after installing in a new directory, copy and paste (replace) the '**configuration.ini**' file from the previous GS1net directory to the new GS1net installation directory (directory references may need to be updated).

3. **Open** the GS1net Browser Template and select 'Browser Configuration'. Check to ensure that configuration settings are correct.

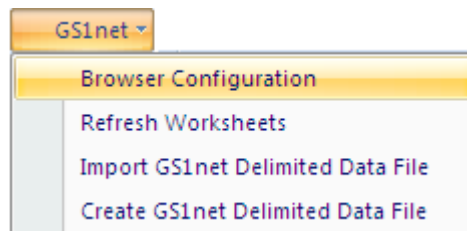


Figure 3 - Browser Configuration Menu Command

4. **Select** 'Refresh Item & Price Worksheets' to ensure that data and column selection within the various worksheets are correctly aligned with your Browser Configuration selections.

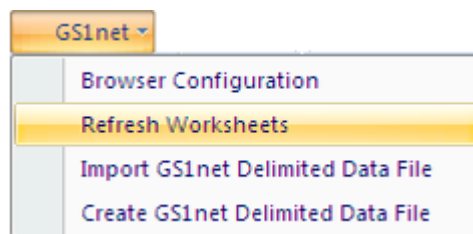


Figure 4 - Importing DDF Menu Command

5. **Import** the downloaded or created DDF into the GS1net Browser Template (as per Options One or Two)

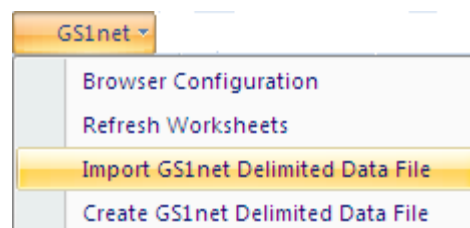


Figure 5 - Importing DDF Menu Command
