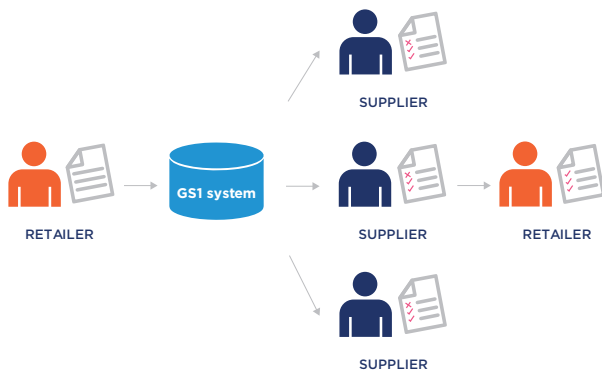

EDI Certify defines a workflow process for the trading partner community.

Steps are provided for the community to follow and, once required processes are completed, trading partners receive EDI Certify certification and can begin electronic trading.

TEST DATA GENERATION
