
Sydney Trains: 2-part label

GS1 Digital Link

Similar to a URL, GS1 Digital Link enables web connections to all types of B2B and B2C information. It's like a bridge between physical products and their digital twins - digital assets are linked to each other through a common identity that also links to the actual physical product.

For those in the rail industry, it can provide installers and maintainers with access to manuals.




GS1 Insight App
