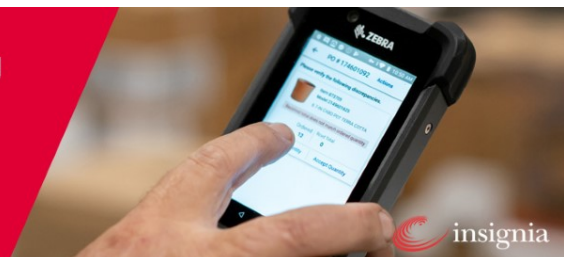

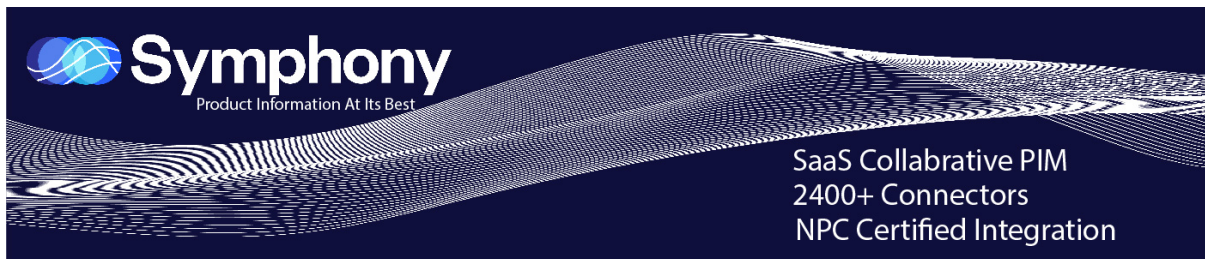
National Location Registry

This is a central database that allows "Location Owners" to load validated location information online. And then shared with authorised users. Location information for each location record can include:

- Trading or operating hours for peak periods
- Safety constraints at a site
- Driver amenities
- Weight/height restrictions
